

ORDINANCE NO. 631

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ATV, WORK SITE UTILITY VEHICLES, GOLF CARTS, AND MICRO UTILITY TRUCKS ARTICLE OF TRAFFIC CODE OF THE CITY OF ST. FRANCIS, KANSAS UNDER ARTICLE 7 OF CHAPTER 14 BY AMENDING SECTION 14-703.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ST. FRANCIS, KANSAS, that Section 14-703 of Article 7 of Chapter 14 of the 2015 Code of the City of St. Francis, Kansas is hereby amended to read as follows:

14-703 SAME; VALID DRIVER'S LICENSE REQUIRED; PENALTY; FLAG REQUIRED; PENALTY; DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES-

(a) No person shall operate a special purpose vehicle on any public highway, street, road or alley within the corporate limits of the city unless such person has a valid driver's license. Violation of this section is punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000 or by imprisonment for not more than six months or by both such fine and imprisonment.


(b) No person shall operate a special purpose vehicle on any public highway, street, road or alley within the corporate limits of the city unless such special purpose vehicle has affixed to it a flag of any color, of neon shade, the top of which is not less than six feet above the ground, and visible from a distance of thirty feet. Violation of this section is punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000 or by imprisonment for not more than six months or by both such fine and imprisonment.

(c) Every person operating a work-site utility vehicle on the public highways, streets, roads and alleys of the city shall be subject to all of the duties applicable to a driver of a vehicle imposed by law.


This amendment to the 2015 Code of the City of St. Francis, Kansas shall be effective upon its publication in the *St. Francis Herald and Bird City Times*.
